1. What is the purpose of this programme?

The ICE-DEP programme is a human capital development initiative aimed at training engineering graduates to become competent local workforce as engineers/executives in the industry, particularly in the automotive sector and its ecosystem. This programme helps to rapidly enhance talent and knowledge within the industry.

2. Who is eligible to participate in this programme?

- Open to Bumiputera citizens
- Engineering Degree graduates in Automotive, Mechanical, Manufacturing, Electrical & Electronics, or Mechatronics
- Aged between 20 to 27 years old
- Minimum CGPA of 2.70
- Physically fit and with no criminal record

The programme runs for 1 month.

6. What types of modules are included in the in-class training?

- **30% soft skills**
- **70% technical skills**
