1. What is the purpose of this programme?

The IPC programme aims to produce a skilled local workforce to meet industry demands, particularly in the automotive sector and its ecosystem. The programme also ensures that participants are equipped with a wide range of competencies, including knowledge, skills, experience, and industry culture required to perform their roles effectively.

2. Who is eligible to participate in this programme?

- Open to Bumiputera citizens
- SPM graduates / Malaysian Skills Certificate (Level 1-3) / Diploma / Malaysian Skills Diploma holders
- Aged between 20 to 27 years old
- Physically fit and with no criminal record

5. How long is the programme?

The programme runs for 1 month.

6. What types of modules are included in the in-class training?

The training modules consist of a combination of:

- **30% soft skills**
- **70% technical skills**

These are industry-recognised and tailored to current industry needs.
